

LAW

TO AMEND THE NASARAWA GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION
SERVICE LAW 2017

Enacted by the Nasarawa State House of Assembly:

Enactment.

SECTION

1. This Law may be cited as the Nasarawa Geographic Information Service (Amendment) Law 2020 and Shall be deemed to have come into effect on the day of 2020. *Citation and Commencement.*

This law seeks to amend S.2 (2) iii, S.3, S.7(i), S.7 (iv) c, S.13, S.14 of the principal Law.


2. S.2 (2) iii of the Principal Law is amended by substituting the word “domiciled” with the words “a parastatal in” to read:

“NAGIS shall be a parastatal in the Office of the Governor of Nasarawa State.”

- 3(1) S.3 (3) of the principal law is amended and replaced with the following:

“The advisory Board shall be composed as follows:

- (a) A Part-time Chairman;*
- (b) Attorney-General of Nasarawa State or his representative;*
- (c) The Chairman of Land Use and Allocation Committee;*
- (d) One person from Nigerian Institute of Estate Surveyors and Valuers, Nasarawa State Chapter;*
- (e) The NAGIS Director-General (as a non-voting member) and*
- (f) The NAGIS Advisory Board shall also double as the*

State Land Use Allocation Committee as provided in the Land Use Act."

- (2) S.3 of the principal Law is amended by creating an additional subsection (4) to read thus;

S.3(4) "All members of the Advisory Board of NAGIS shall be part-time members except the Director-General and Attorney-General of Nasarawa State or his representative".

- 4(1) S.7 (i) line (2) of the principal law is amended by deleting the word "information" and replaced with the word "Administration" to read: "Land Administration System (LAS)".

- (2) S.7 (iv) c of the principal law is further amended to replace the word "information" with the word "Administration" to read thus; "Land Administration System (LAS)"

5. S.13(5) (6) and (7) of the principal law is deleted and amended and a new Section 13(5) to read thus:

Appointment, promotion and dismissal of Staff.

S.13 (5)- The Appointment, promotions and dismissals of Staff of NAGIS shall be in accordance with the Nasarawa State Public Service Rules, 2017 on the request of NAGIS to Nasarawa State Civil Service Commission.


- 6(1) *S.14 (1) "The Director General of NAGIS to be appointed by the Governor and shall have at least a Bachelor's Degree or its equivalent in any field with not less than 7years cognate experience in geospatial information systems, information technology and/or Land Administration.*

Qualification of Director General of NAGIS.

- (2) S.14 (2) of the principal Law is amended by deleting the entire subsection (2) and replacing same with:

Remuneration and Allowances of Director General.

S.14(2) "The Director General shall be paid such remuneration and allowances as may be determined by the Governor".
